Welcome to the Mountaineer Kennel Club agility trials... we hope you enjoy yourselves and that we see you again next year (check <http://www.mkclub.org/> for updates to this and future trials)! You'll find confirmations for your entries included in this mailing; please review them carefully and report any errors or missing information to the Secretary ASAP. Move-ups are due by **6pm on Monday, April 10th**.

Setup: The building will open at 7am each day for exhibitors

Check-in: Those exhibitors who indicated no need for measurements and have no other special check-in requirements should simply check in on the ringside gate sheets. Please also check the posted "Refund Due" sheets to see whether you need to pick up a refund check. No armbands will be issued!

Measuring: If your dog needs to be measured, please be prepared to do this **prior to running** - allow some extra time to do this prior to the start of judging. We currently DO NOT expect a VMO to be in attendance - all dogs w/o a measurement MUST be measured by a judge before running.

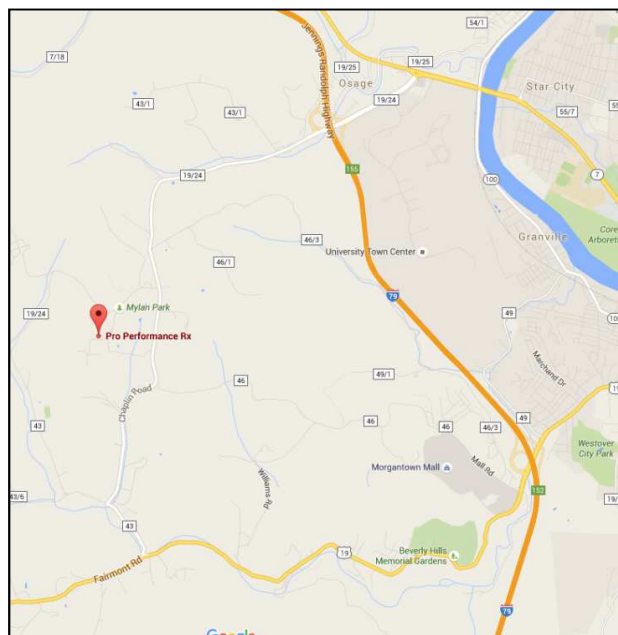

- Running order all days: **4→24"**
- STD & JWW & FAST: Novice B, A, and Preferred will run **together by height**, as will Open & Open Pref; Premier & PremierP; and Mas, MasP, Ex & ExP.
- Mas/Exc STD/JWW will be split into **3 walkthroughs (4/8/12, 16, 20/24)** minimum. T2B, FAST & Nov/Op/Premier STD/JWW will not be split by height.
- **IF YOU THINK YOU MIGHT HAVE A CONFLICT - THEN PLEASE WALK &/or RUN WITH AN EARLIER HEIGHT!** (or be prepared to sacrifice your firstborn...)

Show Site Info and Directions (ProPerformanceRX Indoor Sports Center, 460 Mylan Park Lane, Morgantown, WV 26501):



Directions to Mylan Park:

From the North or West: I-79 southbound to Exit 155 (Star City/Morgantown). Turn RIGHT onto Chaplin Hill Road and continue approximately 1.2 miles to Mylan Park, on your right. If coming from the West, I-70 links to I-79 at Washington, PA.

From the South or East: I-79 northbound to Exit 155 (Star City/Morgantown). Turn LEFT onto Chaplin Hill Road and continue approximately 1.2 miles to Mylan Park, on your right. If coming from the East, use I-68 which links to I-79 just south of Morgantown.

Indoor restrooms will be available at the show site.

RV parking will be allowed at the trial site; however, there are no electrical hook-ups and no dumping. **RV parking may also be available at:** Chestnut Ridge Regional Park (304-594-1773); Coopers Rock State Park (304-594-1561) outside of Morgantown; or Mt. Morris, PA Travel Trailer Park (724-324-2432).

Parking: Overnight parking is permitted on site, beginning Thursday at 7 p.m. All RV units must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained and NO dumping is allowed. There are no RV hook-ups on site.

The facility is open for its fitness center members during trial hours. There will be a designated parking area for them, please do not park there.

Crating: Exhibitors will have access to the building Thursday from 6 pm to 9 pm. Please be considerate and take only the space that you need in order to insure room for everyone. Mats or tarps must be placed under crates, ex-pens, water bowls, chairs, etc. No straight leg chairs on field turf.

Volunteers: There will be a sign up board at the trial; please help when you are

available. \$4 tickets good at vendors or towards future entries will be given to volunteers.

Please clean up after your dogs! This show is being held at a private sports facility. **No dogs are allowed in the restrooms!**
