

## Special Notice re: Zanesville Worker Vouchers

Hi everyone!

First, we want to start off by saying “thank you” to everyone who volunteers to work at the POTC-managed trials in Zanesville. We couldn’t continue to have all these great events without your help to fill the many worker slots that need to be staffed at an agility trial!

However, there seems to be some confusion recently regarding usage of the worker vouchers that we issue as a thank-you to the volunteers:

- 1) Only the white \$5 vouchers can be used to pay for your entry fees at future trials. The blue \$3 vouchers must be used at the trials, at any vendor or for food/concessions. If you’re confused, please just read the vouchers – it states on their fronts how you can use each of them.
- 2) There is \*no connection\* between the POTC-hosted trials in Zanesville (POTC, BTCA, GRCCO, COSSA), and any other trials held at any other sites. So you cannot use the worker vouchers you earn in Zanesville for trials held at any other site! It’s just like going to Vegas – “What Happens in Zanesville, Stays in Zanesville”! 😊

Below you'll find ring assignments and the running schedule for the weekend. Please plan your arrival accordingly; also those of you who generously volunteered to work will receive a worker assignment schedule so that you can plan your weekend.

**Check-in:** Exhibitors who indicated no need for measurements and have no other special check-in requirements should simply check in on the ringside gate sheets. Everyone should also check the posted "refund due" sheets to see whether you need to pick up a refund check. No armbands will be issued!!

**Measuring:** If you checked "my dog needs to be measured", please be prepared to have your dog measured **prior to running** - please allow some extra time to do this prior to the start of judging. We should have a VMO present all days - all dogs w/o a height card **MUST** be measured.

### Ring 2 (JWW)

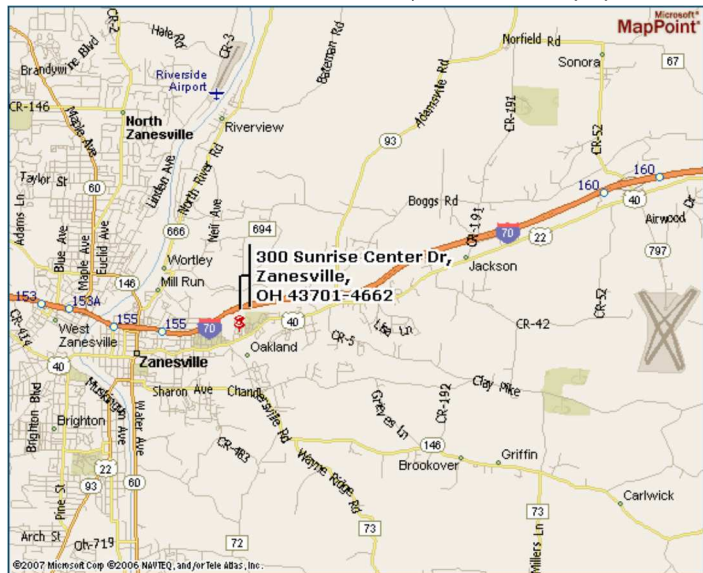
8:00 Novice JWW walk/briefing

- Running order: **4" to 24"** all three days
- STD & JWW: Novice B/A/P will run together by height in that order, as will Open/OpPref; Mas/MasP/Ex/ExP; and Prem/PremP
- Mas/Exc STD/JWW will be split into 5 walkthroughs (4/8, 12 16, 20, 24/26). FAST & Nov/Open STD/JWW will not be split by height.
- **IF YOU THINK YOU MIGHT HAVE A CONFLICT - THEN PLEASE WALK &/or RUN WITH AN EARLIER HEIGHT!** (or be prepared to sacrifice your kneecaps...)

## Show Site Info and Directions (Fieldhouse Family Sports & Wellness Center, 300 Sunrise Ctr, Zanesville OH 43701):



**Food and indoor restrooms will be available** at the show site. **Food concessions will operate from 11am-1pm each day at a minimum;** extended hours may be offered solely at the discretion of the facility. **Overnight RV parking & camping at the show site is permitted;** please contact Trial Chair if questions. No dogs may be left unsupervised overnight at the site, but crates/ex-pens may be left at the owner's risk. **There will NOT be general crating set up Fridays evening. However, if you can help with set-up on Friday evening, please contact Glenn Rawsky ([smawsky@furrydogs.com](mailto:smawsky@furrydogs.com)).** We need a **limited** number of workers to help, who will be allowed to set up crates after trial set up is complete. The building will **open at 7:00 AM Saturday morning** for set up. There is plenty of space; however everyone is **REQUIRED** to place a waterproof tarp/mat underneath crates and chairs to protect the track. This will be strictly enforced!! **Please clean up after your dogs!** This show is being held at a private sports facility. **No dogs are allowed in the restrooms!**

### Directions:

**From the East,** take I-70 to Exit 157; turn left (South) on SR-93 for 0.2mi; then turn right (West) onto US-22/US-40. Travel West for 1.1mi; Sunrise Center will be on your right (North).

**From the West,** take I-70 to Exit 155 for OH-60S/OH-146E. Bear left onto Elberon Ave; go 0.1mi, and turn right (South) onto OH-60S/146E. Travel

0.2mi and turn left (East) onto US-22/US-40. Travel East for 1.2mi; Sunrise Center will be on your left (North).

**Hotel Info:** Many area hotels accept well-mannered dogs and handlers; some may charge additional fees for pets, so please call ahead to verify acceptance. Please clean up after your pets at the hotels! They are considered extensions of the show site, and we have requested these properties to notify us of any problems so that appropriate actions may be taken. The Exit 155 hotels are closest to the show site; Exit 160 hotels are a couple miles further (although only ~5 minutes farther). There are additional hotels ~20 minutes East and West of Zanesville (including a Red Roof). 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**SPECIAL REMINDER:**

Please remember that dogs are to be pottied only in either (a) the areas behind the building, or (b) on the GRASS surfaces in front of the building. Do not let your dogs relieve themselves on any man-made object or surface in either area! (i.e. raised landscaped areas including the shrubs & mulch in them, or parking blocks, bag dispensers, trash cans, ramps, railings, stairs, your (ex-)friend's car, etc) So when bringing your dogs into the building, please do not allow yourself to be distracted because you're dragging a load of crates at the same time (make two trips – it's not that hard!), or stop to talk to your friends, etc – there's plenty of time for that later! 😊

Remember that the Fieldhouse has paying members who are using the facility while we are there as their guests, and we need to create as little an imposition on them as possible... otherwise we run the risk of not being allowed to hold agility trials there in the future. Anyone caught violating these rules will be asked to leave for the remainder of the weekend with no refund of fees, and may be subject to disciplinary charges. Please – keep an eye on your own dogs, and also those of your friends! We all want to have trials here for many years to come!

**2nd SPECIAL REMINDER - Concessions:**

Yes, there will be food concessions – either Harriet (Fieldhouse) or a local organization trying to raise some needed \$. Hours of operation are solely at their discretion; but the more you support them, the more likely they'll be open longer. There are also several nearby restaurants available.
