Welcome to the Winter Columbus All-breed Training Club agility trial at ARF... we hope you enjoy yourselves and that we see you again in January (check www.furrydogs.com for updates to this and future trials)! You'll find confirmations for your entries included in this mailing; please review them carefully and report any errors or missing information to the Secretary ASAP. Move-ups are due by **6pm on Monday, January 9th**. Below you'll find the running schedule for the weekend. Please plan your arrival accordingly.

Waitlist: There are NO waitlists for any day(s). Thus no post-closing withdrawals are possible, since they cannot be backfilled.

Check-in: Exhibitors who indicated no need for measurements and have no other special check-in requirements should simply check in on the ringside gate sheets. Refunds *might* be available at the trial, but if not they will be mailed (check with scoring if you are due a refund).

Measuring: We currently expect that there will be a VMO; but if not, "Judge of Record measuring" has been resumed, so if you checked "my dog needs to be measured", please have the judge measure you before you run... actually, we don't care how tall you are, please have your dog measured instead! Be sure to arrive early enough to allow plenty of time/opportunities to get this done!

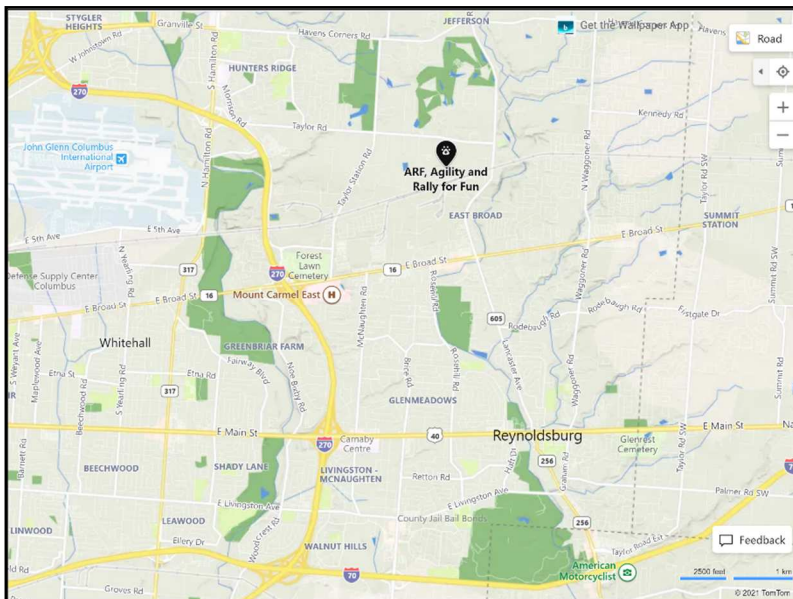

- Running order: **24" to 4"** all days
- **M/E STD/JWW walks:** Mas/Exc STD/JWW be split into at least 2 walk groups: 24-20-16 will Walk-Walk-Run (or Walk-Run, depending on the number of handlers present each day), then 12-4 will Walk-Run
- **FAST:** M/E/O/N will Walk-Walk in 2 equal groups; then M/E run - N/O run. Nov+Op will run "intermixed" by height; please check the gate boards for details
- Walks for Premier, T2B and Nov/Open classes will **not** be split by height
- **THERE IS NO REASON FOR CONFLICTS with only one ring** – so please be on-time at ringside for your runs! (or be prepared to sacrifice your kneecaps...)

Agility & Rally for Fun (ARF), 659 Eastgate Parkway, Gahanna, OH 43230

Lunch will be a "pot luck" meal – everyone who brings a dish will be entered in a raffle each day for one of several \$25 gift cards; and Workers/Volunteers will be provided bottled water and snacks. There are also a variety of casual and fast food restaurants within a ~10 mile drive.

The building will be opened at 7am all days

Indoor crating space is limited. Workers will have priority for indoor crating but as long as there is adequate space, everyone is welcome to crate indoors.

Crates may be left overnight **only if you are entered the next day**; however, neither CATC nor ARF will be responsible for lost or damaged items left at the site.

Parking – On Friday you can park anywhere in back except immediately in front of any business doors. NOTE: please watch for construction debris in the back! CATC and ARF will not be responsible

for any injury or vehicle damage. On **Saturday/Sunday** you may also park in front except in front of the last building in the row. **Overnight or RV parking is NOT permitted.** Please contact Trial Chair if questions – (Brenda - buckeye1661@yahoo.com)

Please clean up after your dogs! This show is being held at a private training facility. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without a refund if the Trial Committee determines there has been a violation. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Directions to ARF: (if using GPS – don't just search for "ARF" - be sure to use their new address: **659 Eastgate Parkway, Gahanna, OH 43230**)

From I-270 near the airport, take Exit 39 (OH-16/E Broad St) Eastbound; turn North (left) onto Taylor Station Rd for 1.7mi; then turn right (East) onto Taylor Rd for 0.8mi; then turn right (South) onto Eastgate Pkwy. ARF will be on your right.

If for some reason your GPS cannot recognize the above address or mis-directs you, try: **Buckeye Landscape Service 6608 Taylor Rd, Blacklick, OH** which should get you to the corner of Taylor Rd and Eastgate Parkway
