


Directions to the Trial and Show Site Information

Food and indoor restrooms will be available at the show site.

Overnight RV parking & camping at the show site is permitted (NO FEE); there is plenty of space. However, no services are available. Contact the Trial Coordinator if you have specific auestions. No dogs may be left unsupervised overnight at the show site, but crates/ex-pens/shelters may be left at the owner's risk.

Please clean up after your dogs! This show is being held at a fitness center. No dogs are allowed in the restrooms!

Directions: From the East, take 1-70 to Exit 157; turn left (South) on SR-93 for 0.2mi; then turn right (West) onto US-22/US-40. Travel West for 1.1mi; Sunrise Center will be on your right (North). From the West, take 1-70 to Exit 155 for OH-60S/OH-146E. Bear left onto Elberon Ave; go 0.1mi, and turn right (South) onto OH-60S/146E. Travel 0.2mi and turn left (East) onto US-22/US-40. Travel East for 1.2mi; Sunrise Center will be on your left (North).



Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **Puppies** under 4 months of age are prohibited from the show grounds.

All dogs must be on leash or confined except when being judged or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with <u>signed Agreement</u> and Instructions attached cannot be accepted.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express delivery entries must include a signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address without the recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to sender.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. Confirmation of acceptance will be made if either an email address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard with checkboxes for each class entered is included with the entry.

Owners are responsible for **errors made while filling out entry forms**, whoever makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully to minimize errors! Every effort will be made to find all **duplicate entries**; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Make all checks and money orders **payable to POTC** in US funds only. Please mail fees with entries. The Trial Secretary and GRCCO assume no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Postdated or returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the event committee. Bitches in season, aggressive or blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured*List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. It is solely the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the correct measurement box, enter your dog(s) in the correct jump height, have your dog(s) measured before running (if necessary), and to have your dog(s) height card(s) available to present, if requested.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All heights are as measured at the withers

Regular Class (Preferred Class) jump height divisions:

Dogs entered in **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above.

Random Draw

Entries accepted no sooner than Tuesday, November 1 at 8am; finish date for entry into the random draw opening period is Wednesday, November 16 at 4pm.

Random draw will be held on Thursday, Nov 17 at 7pm, at the Trial Secretary's home (see pg2). Entries close 4pm Tuesday, December 13th. If entry limits are not reached during the opening period, they will be filled on a "first received" basis until the closing date.

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary for the random draw. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned.

In the event an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit, there will be a random draw of the individual entries contained therein to fill the specified entry limit.

If the entry limit is reached during the draw, all remaining entries shall be drawn for a position on the waitlist.

All Random Draw rules and regulations as they appear in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Regulations for Agility Trials shall apply.

Move-Ups

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
