
# Directions to the Trial and Show Site Information

Food and indoor restrooms will be available at the show site.

Overnight RV parking & camping at the show site is permitted (NO FEE); there is plenty of space. However, no services are available. Contact the Trial Chair if you have specific questions. No doas may be left unsupervised overnight at the show site, but crates/ex-pens/shelters may be left at the owner's risk.

## Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited from the show grounds.

**All dogs must be on leash** or confined except when being judged or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

\*\*\*Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with <u>signed Agreement</u> and Instructions attached cannot be accepted.\*\*\*

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express delivery entries must include a signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address without the recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to sender.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. Confirmation of acceptance will be made if either an email address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard with checkboxes for each class entered is included with the entry.

Owners are responsible for **errors made while filling out entry forms**, whoever makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully to minimize errors! Every effort will be made to find all **duplicate entries**; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Make all checks and money orders **payable to POTC** in US funds only. Please mail fees with entries. The Trial Secretary and POTC assume no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Post-dated or returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed in the event of riots, civil disturbances, fire, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees less \$5 per run will be refunded for injured dogs or bitches in season on the day of the trial if veterinary certification is presented by the close of the final trial of the weekend. Overpayment of less than \$10 per day will not be refunded except at the exhibitor's request.

**Exhibitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. Handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when it is their turn to run. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

The Bedlington Terrier Club of America, and its agents assume **no responsibility for any loss,** damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs or property, or their children.

# Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the doa's physical or mental performance are inclinible to participate.

# Class Information (see also Chapters 6-9 of the Regulations for Agility Trials)

All dogs entering Preferred classes for the first time must enter at the Novice level; there is no grandfathering of Regular titles. **Dogs must be entered only in Preferred or in Regular classes**, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials.

All obstacles will conform to requirements as specified in the current revision of the "Regulations for Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club (available at www.akc.org).

\*\* Rubberized contact surfaces will be used at the trial.\*\*

# Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured*List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. It is solely the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the correct measurement box, enter your dog(s) in the correct jump height, have your dog(s) measured before running (if necessary), and to have your dog(s) height card(s) available to present, if requested.

# **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All heights are as measured at the withers

#### **Regular Class**/*Preferred Class*/jump height divisions:

Dogs entered in **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above.

## Random Draw

Entries accepted no sooner than Tuesday, July 16 at 8am; finish date for entry into the random draw opening period is Wednesday July 31 at 4pm.

Random draw will be held on Thursday, August 1 at 7pm, at the Trial Secretary's home (see pg2). Entries close 4pm Tuesday, August 27. If entry limits are not reached during the opening period, they will be filled on a "first received" basis until the closing date.

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary for the random draw. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned.

In the event an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit, there will be a random draw of the individual entries contained therein to fill the specified entry limit.

If the entry limit is reached during the draw, all remaining entries shall be drawn for a position on the waitlist.

All Random Draw rules and regulations as they appear in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Regulations for Agility Trials shall apply.

# Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner. This request must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6pm on Monday, September 9th, by mail or e-mail (see form on p.9). Day-to-day move-ups must be requested in writing at the trial site before the close of trial on the preceding day.

# Confirmations, Corrections, Entry Changes, and E-mail

Per AKC regulations, changes to entries may be made until the closing date. After that time, only moveups are permitted until the moveup deadline. Corrections to entries due to Secretarial error may be requested at any time; however, any day-of-show corrections cannot be guaranteed to be reported to AKC correctly!! Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
